On behalf of the Executive Standards Council (ExSC), I am pleased to inform you that the reaccreditation of Accredited Standards Committee OP, Optics and Electro-Optical Instruments under its recently revised operating procedures for documenting consensus on ASC OP-sponsored American National Standards and with OEOSC continuing as Secretariat, has been administratively approved effective March 15, 2013. This reaccreditation action relates to the version of ASC OP's revised procedures forwarded to my attention on March 14, 2013 - a copy of this document will be placed in the ASC's accreditation file at ANSI.

Please be advised that this decision may be appealed in accordance with section 17, ExSC Hearing of Appeals, of the Operating Procedures of the Executive Standards Council. The ExSC and its Audit Subcommittee reserve the right to request additional changes to ASC OP's accredited procedures as a result of any new procedural requirements issued with future versions of the ANSI Essential Requirements, or if any additional instances of non-compliance missed during the current review are later identified during a subsequent audit.
