The WG3 working group for the revision of 8980 1&2 as well as 21987 were very busy on a tight timeline. The group held 2 hours conference calls every other week for 8 weeks to ensure all non-technical comments had been addressed prior to the Sydney meeting. This allow the WG to concentrate all it's efforts in resolving the

technical issues at the Sydney meeting which then allowed the 3 standards to be released for FDIS on time.
