

Foreword to OP version of ISO 9211-2

Foreword to the American National Standard edition

This part of national standard XXXXXXXX indicates how to specify optical properties of coatings and to represent their spectral characteristics graphically. It is based entirely on the international standard ISO 9211-2:2010.

In its implementation as a national standard, however, some accommodations must be made for standard practice in the United States. This requires the following modifications.

- 1) The capital letter T is substituted for the Greek letter τ to represent spectral transmittance.
- 2) The capital letter R is substituted for the Greek letter ρ to represent spectral reflectance.
